Activity 2.1 Creating Clouds

Objectives:

To explore the role of condensation in weather. To observe how clouds are formed from water vapor in the presence of condensation nuclei.

Materials:

- Mayonnaise or pickle jar with lid
- 2 ice cubes
- Hot water
- Match
- WEATHERlogs

Procedure:

- 1. Pour the hot water into the jar to a height of about 1 cm.
- 2. Turn the jar lid upside down and place the ice cubes in the lid.
- 3. Light the match and drop it into the jar.
- 4. Place the jar lid on top of the jar with the top of the lid on the top of the jar and the ice still sitting in the lid.
